

Terms of Entry

I have read and agree to the following Terms of Entry for the 2026 WA Youth Awards. The nominee has read and agrees to the following Terms of Entry.

Nominations

- All nomination forms and supporting documents are due by Monday 8 June 2026.
 - The Youth Affairs Council of WA (YACWA) reserves the right to extend this deadline.
- Past winners are not eligible to be nominated for a category they have previously won.
- Current YACWA employees are not eligible to be nominated for a category that honours individuals.
- Nominees must reside in Western Australia.
- Nominees may be entered into multiple categories.
- For nominees under 18 years old, a parent/guardian must consent to these terms and conditions.
- The nominee is aged 10-25 as at 11 September 2026 (not applicable to those entering the Minister for Youth's Most Outstanding Youth Worker Award, The YWA Collective Action Award, or Youth Focus Sector Collaboration Award).
 - Nominees entering the Commissioner for Children and Young People's Rising Voice Award must be aged 10-17 as at 11 September 2026.
- The nominee's contact details will be included on a mailing list for the purpose of the WA Youth Awards.
- YACWA can contact the media about the nomination. Permission may be withdrawn by contacting YACWA in writing at events@yacwa.org.au.
- YACWA may nominate the nominee for other award programs (applicable only to nominations of individuals).
- YACWA may use any information, photographs, or other creative media such as video clips, audio, or art provided in addressing the selection criteria to promote the 2026 WA Youth Awards. Permission may be withdrawn by contacting YACWA in writing at events@yacwa.org.au.
- All nomination material and information remains the property of YACWA unless permission is withdrawn in writing at events@yacwa.org.au.
- Award judges reserve the right to request additional information to support the nomination if required.
- Category winners of individual Awards will be considered for the WA Young Person of the Year Award.

- The winner of The Minister for Youth's Most Outstanding Youth Worker Award will be considered for the WA Young Person of the Year Award only if they are under the age of 26 as at 11 September 2026.
- All information and statements concerning this nomination are true and correct.

Attendance

- The nominee will attend the WA Youth Awards gala ceremony in Perth on Friday 11 September 2026 if they are chosen as a finalist (financial assistance for travel and accommodation will be made available to regional finalists).
 - Finalists will receive one (1) complimentary ticket to the gala ceremony.
 - Finalists under the age of 18 as at 11 September 2026 will instead receive two (2) complimentary tickets, with one intended for a parent, guardian or support person.
 - Finalists for The Y WA Collective Action Award and Youth Focus Sector Collaboration Award will instead receive five (5) complimentary tickets, indiscriminate of age.
- The nominee will participate in any media interviews or photographic opportunities where possible, the products of which will be used to promote youth sector interests and issues.
 - Where possible, finalists will be required to attend a photo day in Perth on Tuesday 7 July. Considerations will be made for regional finalists.
- Finalists will be required to attend a judging interview in Perth on 14 or 15 July. Online interviews will be considered where appropriate.
- Category winners may be called on as youth ambassadors or sector ambassadors throughout the following year.
- Finalists will have access to, and are encouraged to, attend free leadership opportunities provided by RAC WA.
